Cape Cod Trail Race Update – Matt Auger

74 registered – 61 ran – low numbers may have been due to less advertisement/effort this time around, but everyone loved it. Distance numbers were split evenly. Runners were happy about the hat gift. Lost money due to volunteer aids, port o potties and donations. Chris Risko and Mike Falcone were excellent at helping and marking course, running & walking course to make sure all was ok. Up for discussion is do we do another in August (27^{th} ?) – same distances of 10k, 20k. Will keep it minimal but maybe add shell medals, no volunteer group needed this time around (just need members from the Club – possible 10 total) Would like to have an emergency type vehicle available. Will have a better advertising campaign and will bring the number up to 250 runners. To still offer food and port a potties & maybe a tent. Future discussion is to offer 50k relay for Spring 2023 (longer races require a lot of time) BOD may have to approve new race. Still in discussion stage – need approvals. No problem with bikers.

WRCC 5K Update – Mary Tolland

176 registered runners – 18 participants under 18 years old and 158 over 18 years of age. There were 28 no shows. Many loved running with their mothers and/or daughters, lots of great comments post-race. \$4k plus was earned (to date on Race Roster). Mary will make donations to GOTR & FHS girl's track. Wrap up meeting to be held next week. No awards or categories this year – maybe next year. In the future we'll publicize more in our community. Looking forward to next year. Announcer and timer did great job. Mary met with duty police officer to set course/race straight. Officer showed up in his own car, but we needed lead vehicle - things worked out. Lead vehicle did great job even at turn around spot. Mary offered runners great enthusiasm. The only male that registered did not show up. Prior to WRCC5k FRC reached out to other 'female' only races and got advice on what to do if a male signs up. Males can register but receive no recognition or prizes/etc. Matt: can ZOOMA (another local women only race) reach out to FRC – Matt to advise later

Surf Drive Mile Update – Jack Afarian

Last race this spring to be held May 22nd. So far there are 103 registered runners. Medals (similar to CCM kid's race) were donated by Ashworth. 150 T-shirts were donated by USA Racing.
