Things are going well. 197 reg as of now. Will finish loose ends before weekend. Bibs are in. Shirts are in. Police, Site Services (port a potties) are all confirmed. Saturday is pre-race bib pick up at Timber Axe Bar & Bowl. Online registration closes Friday night at 11:59pm. Social posts are going out. Mile markers are painted. Wrapping up before weekend.
