Jack – Financials regarding all our races – The Seagull Six made \$1800+/- and Women Run Cape Cod made \$2000+/- . The trail race was negative but good to get back on the calendar. The Surf Drive Mile had a loss of \$1100 – The timer for this event was more expensive and we charge a very low entry fee. Should we continue at a lower registration cost or increase fee for SDM. Let's keep SDM at same cost. The Marathon expenses are higher, at this point in time than last year.

Chris – net income \$49k compared to last year at \$67k. The big expenses are the awards & volunteer apparel. Maybe shift the MMA account into a CD account, if feasible, especially if we have extra money.

- **Cape Cod Marathon Update** – Jack Afarian

- Registrations are going strong as of 07/12/2022
- Marathon – 1,134 registrations– may need to get more shirts & medals soon
- Half – 1,610 registrations – we will surpass our 1700 limit
- Chowdah Challenge – 80 registrations
- Relay – 71 teams

- 5K – 112 registrations
- Kids – 39 registrations
- 75% of Deferred 2021 entrants have registered for the 2022 races – deferral codes expired on 7/2/22 – (total deferral fees entry from 2021 is \$173K)
- Relay Medals/all medals have been received – We have runners from 43 states & other countries
- CCM Rack Cards have been received and are being distributed by Maggi Yates
- Chowdah Challenge Mugs have been ordered (white with blue print)
- Pint Glasses for Relay Team winners have been ordered – men/women/mixed top teams get pint glass for their team. Winners get free entry to 2023 Relay
- Jack attended the Utica Boilermaker 15K Expo on July 8-10 to promote CCM Weekend – registrations were extremely low this year. Lot of interest in our races.
- Museums on Green have a wedding event this year and we can't use their space for our tents at finish line. Jack sent letter to the town with other options. Sunday morning bib pick up is in tent. Historical events (50 years) can use the Village Green for a tent (good location – no traffic, electric is available, convenient). CCM is on the special events meeting's agenda at end of week to review request to have our tent on the Green
- Relay exchange 2 is at Kenyon's market which is for sale. Hopefully, the new owner gives ok. (Should not be issue)
