**Chris –** Net income year-to-date is at \$78.6k, compared to \$40.0k last year at this time. The Club's total assets is now at \$304.5k, with no debt. (via email)

**Old Business - Updates**

○ **CCM - Jack**

- Wyoming is now on the map!
- 2024 - 262 registered this time last year – as of today we have 398. The half had 392 in 2024, today it's at 402 + 78 in 10k challenge, the 5k had 48 in 2024 and today we have 56, the chowdah challenge had 13 in 2024 and today it's at 25, the relay had 17 teams last year and today we have 19 team. The kids run had 20 in 2024 and today it's at 27. Registrations are trending up. April trends higher (probably due to Boston Marathon)
- Therapy dogs will be a trial for 2025
- Shirts – design is finalized – should be ordered in May/June
- Medals will be similar to 2024 but a silver color instead of gold (relay will be exact)

○ **SDM - Ron**

- SDM construction at the race site should all be completed and the parking lot should be cleared so we should have no issues. We have received the medal ribbons, and a T-shirts are on order. I would like to discuss potentially doing the bib pick up at the run house, but we can discuss that later. (via email)

- **WRCC**
  - 151 Registered so far
  - Early bib pick up at Run House and Timber Axe Bar
  - Sponsorship is around \$5k and many in-kind donations for raffles (tickets sold at bib pickup)
  - Timing/Bibs all set
  - Medals ordered/tanks to be ordered
  - Good shape with everything else
  - Need volunteers for all bib pick ups
- **Seagull six** recap – Quick Budget was passed around (less runners this year due to Paddy Kelly GPS for other clubs)
- **Couch to 5k** update – n/a

### **New Business**

- Grand prix discussion
  - Possible team GPS for 2026 (maybe work with Julianna on this) Bill can help
- Other
  - Jack – donations from Jack's daughter (via Charities Aid Foundation)
    - a donation comes in every month and is matched by her company (\$480/yr). She would like the monies to support the SYP program run by Anne P. Jack would like to have the money support 5 SYP scholarships (no cost – valued at \$410) and asks if Club could donate 3 more for a total of 8. Jack & Anne will discuss the process. Motion was made that Charities Aid Foundation money donations will be allocated to SYP, and 3 other donations will come from FRC. BOD agreed. Kathy to earmark Charities Aid Foundation monies to SYP class.
  - High School Scholarships – only 1 has come in so far. Decisions are made yearly based on need.
