We conducted the first of three CCM Race Committee meetings on Thursday, September 4. Most of the members were able to attend. We discussed all aspects of the weekend event, including the need for more volunteers, the safety of all runners, the timing and start procedure for all races, the post-race X-Tra Mile activities, the Expo and number pickup, post-race food, etc. The second meeting is scheduled for Thursday, September 18.

We had our pre-race meeting with the Falmouth Police Department. The main issue that we have is to try to make Davisville Road safer for the Marathon runners. We will have more signage along the road, police officers will be at the top and bottom of the road and another officer at the entrance to East Falmouth Elementary school, which is the location for Relay Exchange Zone 3. There will be “Resident Traffic Only” signs at the top and bottom of the road. We will also have an officer and more signage at the intersection of the bike path and Elm Road.

We are expecting delivery of the Finisher Medals by Friday, September 12. The Heat Sheets should be delivered the following week. Race Shirts will be delivered to Mullen Hall School on Friday, October 10, along with all race merchandise by USA Racing. Compostable water cups, soup bowls, spoons and napkins have been delivered. We have been approved to hang 30 CCM Pole Banners along Main Street. Locust Street Sign is scheduled to hang the Pole Banners on Saturday, September 13. They will also hang 20 Pole Banners in the Mullen Hall School parking lot. Most of the new signage that we need has been delivered.
